WINTER PARKING BAN - BEGINS NOVEMBER 1ST



To help City crews safely clear snow and ensure emergency vehicles can travel easily, the annual winter parking ban went into effect November 1, 2025.

Per City Ordinance, no parking is allowed on any City street between 2:00 AM and 6:00 AM Beginning November 1, 2025, the Police Department will issue warnings for a two-week grace period. After that, vehicles parked in violation will be ticketed.

FALL LEAF REMOVAL

To help us serve you better:

- · Place leaves in long, narrow rows at the curb.
- Keep limbs, branches, rocks, and animal waste out of piles (they won't be picked up if contaminated).
- Leaves may also be placed in paper yard waste bags or self-hauled to the compost pile at Bogue Flats.
- Burning brush or leaves is prohibited under the Refuse Ordinance.

The last day for loose leaf pickup will be Monday, December 1. Please have leaves at the curb by 7:00 AM that day. After December 1, only paper yard waste bags will be collected.



PARKS, RECREATION, AND CEMETERY

WINTER SPORTS REGISTRATION - Will Open on October 1

- 1ST/2ND GRADE BASKETBALL: Season begins in early January and runs through the middle of February. Teams will practice one night a week and play games on Saturday mornings. Practice days and times will not be established until the December coaches' meeting.
 Deadline: Mon, Dec. 1 - Cost: \$55 to \$80 depending on residency
- **DK/K BASKETBALL:** Leagues will take place in March. There are two available options: Mondays and Wednesdays OR Tuesdays and Thursdays. Teams will practice and scrimmage each hour-long session. Deadline: Mon, Feb 2 Cost: \$45 to \$70 depending on residency
- ADULT BASKETBALL: Games are played on Sundays at Portland High School. There are leagues for both men and women. The four men's divisions available range from A (upper) to D (lower). League play will begin in early December and run into February. Player fees MUST BE paid before first game.
 Deadline: Mon, Nov 10 Cost: Team Fee (\$475) + Player Fees (\$20 to \$30 depending on residency)



RECDESK RESIDENCY STATUS UPDATE:

Moving forward, only households within Portland city limits will be considered Residents for registration purposes. Households outside city limits (including Danby and Portland Townships) will be classified as Non-Residents. During registration you'll now select your township/municipality instead of Resident/Non-Resident, so the correct fee is applied.

CONSTRUCTION: APRIL - NOVEMBER 2026


TRAFFIC IMPACTS
