NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 2023-3, AN ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE AN ANNUAL PERMIT FOR RECREATIONAL MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS IN DANBY TOWNSHIP

To the residents and property owners of the Township of Danby, Ionia County, Michigan, and all other interested persons:

On March 23, 2023, the Township of Danby (the "Township") adopted An Ordinance To Require An Annual Permit For Recreational Marihuana Establishments In Danby Township. A true copy of the Ordinance, including any exhibits, is available for inspection on the front doors at the Township Hall, 13122 Charlotte Hwy, Sunfield MI 48890 and on the Township Website at www.danbytwp.org.

Section 3. This section provides definitions as used in the Ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> This section provides which recreational marihuana establishments are permitted in the Township.

<u>Section 5.</u> This section provides general requirements for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 6.</u> This section provides permitting and inspection requirements for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 7.</u> This section provides application requirements for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 8.</u> This section provides the application review process for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 9.</u> This section provides for renewal and transfers of permits for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 10.</u> This section provides the fees for permits for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

Section 11. This section provides for violations and penalties of the Ordinance.

<u>Section 12.</u> This section provides for revocation of permits for recreational marihuana establishments in the Township.

<u>Section 13</u>. This section provides that if any portion of the Ordinance is found invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 14.</u> This section provides that all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed, specifically the Danby Township Recreational Marihuana Establishment Permitting Ordinance.

<u>Section 15</u>. This section provides that the Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after publication.
